- Starts Monday, February 1st, 2021
- Play 6 games per week for 6 weeks (Mon-Sun)
 - Play any time the bowling alley is open
 - Week 6 ends Sunday, March 14th
 - Playoffs will be Saturday, March 27th
- Players will be grouped into divisions and will compete in a Knockout Tournament against other players in their division for cash prizes!
 - **FREE** Entry!

Format

- Each week, there will be 6 assigned games to play.
Week 1 games are Monster Bash, Cyclone, Wheel of Fortune, Taxi, Hot Wheels, and Jurassic Park (Stern)
The next week's games are announced one week prior.
- Grab a scoresheet from the Front Desk. Play each game on the list as many times as you'd like, trying to achieve the highest score. Take a picture of your score with the week # flyer in the picture, and write your score down on your scoresheet.
- Text in your pictures to us at (440) 628-1240 for verification. Turn your scoresheet back in at the front desk to be entered.
 - You can play alone or in groups
- Players will be split into divisions. You will compete against other players in your division for the playoffs.

Scoring / Rules

- The player who comes in first place on a machine for the week receives 100 points, 2nd place gets 99, 3rd 98, so on and so forth...
 - Extra Balls can be played
- If there are any issues with a game, let us know! We try to keep a level playing field for all players, and will try to have a machine in perfect playing condition at all times.
 - In the event of a major breakdown, a game may be dropped for the week.

Playoffs

- Playoffs take place Saturday, March 27th
 - Playtimes will be scheduled as we get closer to the date.
- We'll be using a Group Knockout format, similar to the knockout tournaments we already host. Players will compete against each other in groups of 3 or 4 on different machines. Players that come in 3rd or 4th place on a game will receive a "strike". Play through the rounds until you have 4 strikes.
 - Cash prizes for the top 3 players in each division!
